Bostonians love chowder like we love championships

WORLD CHAMPION CLAM CHOWDER SERVES: 6 | PREP TIME: 25 MINS | COOK TIME: 45 MINS

INGREDIENTS

- 7 pounds medium-size hard-shell clams
- 4 slices of bacon cut into ¼-inch pieces
- 4 large Spanish onions, diced (about 2 cups)
- 4 medium waxy red boiling potatoes, diced
- 2 tablespoons flour
- 1 teaspoon fresh thyme (1/4 tsp dried thyme)
- 2 tablespoons minced parsley ¼ tablespoon of smoked paprika
- 1 cup heavy cream
- 1 large bay leaf
- Salt and ground black pepper to taste

*For additional flavor, you may add bottled clam juice

- 1. Bring 5 cups of water to boil in large pot, add clams and cover. Steam until clams open.
- 2. Transfer clams to large bowl, reserving the liquid from the boil.
- 3. Remove clams from shells with paring knife.
- Put meat in a separate bowl, discard shells.
- 4. Mince clams; set aside.
- 5. Pour most of the boiled water into large bowl. Avoid adding sediment. Clean pot for next step.
- 6. In the large pot, fry bacon until fat renders and bacon crisps, 5 to 7 minutes. 7. Add diced onion to bacon; sauté until softened,
- about 5 minutes. 8. Add flour; stir until lightly colored, about 1 minute.
- 9. Gradually whisk in reserved water from step two clam boil. (Ideally about 4 cups)
- 10. Add potatoes, bay leaf, paprika, thyme. Simmer until potatoes are tender, 10 minutes. 11. Add clams, cream, parsley, salt and pepper to taste;
- bring to simmer.
- 12. Remove from heat and serve.
